Your conference fee includes:

- Friday evening's "hearty" hors d'oeuvres reception and program at the Odawa Hotel, with northern Michigan artist Jerry Gates and MHS member Ken Marek presenting "EH as a visual artist in prose".
- Saturday morning's breakfast at the Odawa and discussion by John Sanford on the relationship of his grandmother's (Grace Hemingway) paintings to her son's (EH) writings. Seán Hemingway, Ernest Hemingway's grandson, will also speak about the "restored" *A Moveable Feast*, which he edited.
- Saturday evening's dinner and program at the Odawa featuring keynote speaker Colette Hemingway on "Hemingway and Art". Colette is the author of the book *in his time*, on Hemingway and the paintings he acquired and his relationship to the artists who created these paintings.
- Sunday morning's breakfast at the Odawa and talk by Patricia Innis, an environmental artist, announcing the photography contest winners and giving an update on the Michigan Legacy Art Park.
- A brief general membership meeting will conclude the conference.

Saturday lunch is **on your own** and the afternoon is free time. Some options are:

- 1) a self-guided driving tour of Hemingway sites in the area
- 2) a self-guided walking tour of Hemingway sites in downtown Petoskey
- 3) a self-guided walking tour of art galleries in Petoskey

- 5) shopping in Petoskey's charming Gaslight District
- 6) time to take a photo for the photo contest
